Student Drop Off and Pick Up-Important Changes for Term 3

From Term 3, Week 1, parents will continue to drop off and pick up students at the school gate. Teachers will be on duty to support this process. Currently, this process is working very well and we appreciate your patience and support. From Week 1, the following arrangements will be in place:

Morning Drop Off:

• **8.30-8.55am**: Please drop your children at the school gate.

Afternoon Pick Up: Please note the changes of times for K-2 release

- **2.40pm**: Kindergarten students and siblings will be released from the front gates as a parent/carer arrives to collect them.
- 2.50pm: Year 1 & 2 students and siblings will be released from the front gates as a parent/carer arrives to collect them.
- **3.00pm**: Remaining Year 3-6 students will be released from classrooms to leave the school via the front gates. Any students who attend Out Of School Hours Care will be picked up by OOSHC employees. Students catching the bus or who have not been picked up to stay with the teacher on Bus Duty.

Visitors To School Grounds

Under Department of Education guidelines, only essential visitors are allowed on school grounds at this stage. Gates are locked after the morning bell rings. If you have an essential reason to visit the school, please contact the school office on 9832 1488 so that we can make arrangements.

Student Reports

We acknowledge the many adjustments that students, parents and the school have made in response to the Covid-19 pandemic. To reflect the impact of learning from home and at school during Term 1 and 2, our Semester 1 reports have been adjusted. Students will not be graded using the usual achievement scale of Outstanding, High, Sound, Basic or Limited in this report.

Your child's report will focus on assessment of his or her progress and suggested next steps in learning in English and mathematics. These reports will be sent home to families in Week 1, Term 3.

Student Absences

Thank you to our families for following the Department of Education and NSW Health guidelines in keeping your children home when they are unwell. Please understand that we will need to contact parents to collect their child immediately if they show any cold or flu symptoms.

If your child is absent, please notify us via the Skoolbag App. You do not need to call or send a note if you submit an absence note on Skoolbag. It is simple to do and you don't risk your child forgetting to hand in a sick note!

Student Lateness

As the mornings are getting colder, we are experiencing an increase in the number of students who are late arriving at school. While it might only seem like 5, 10 or 15 minutes, this is having a significant impact on the learning of all students and on students' ability to start the day in a settled way. Teachers are often having to interrupt lessons to settle in late students and to catch them up on what they have missed. Please try to have your children at school in plenty of time before the school bell rings at 8.55am, so that we can avoid this. Any child who arrives after the bell must go to the office for a late note before going to class.

Student Lunches, Hats, Drink Bottle, Change of Clothes

Please make sure your child has packed their bag with lunch, drink bottle and hat for school each day. We have had a number of students coming to school without these items. Parents of kindergarten students are also asked to pack a change of clothes in their child's bag. Accidents sometimes happen and it is important that we are able to give the child clean clothes to change into, without waiting for clothes to be delivered to school.

Birthday Celebrations

We love a good birthday celebration here at MPS and we love joining your child in celebrating their very exciting day. If you would like to send a treat to school so that your child can celebrate with their class, please make sure that it is an individually wrapped item, such as a Freddo Frog or similar chocolate. Unfortunately, we need to ask you not to send cakes as we are unable to share "communal" food items at this stage. We will still enjoy wishing your beautiful children happy birthday and making their day special, regardless!

We are thrilled to know that the youngest members of our school, who have been so highly impacted by the disruptions to schooling this year, have been provided with this opportunity for smaller classes and highly targeted support. 

How To Install Skoolbag On Your Smartphone

For iPhone and iPad users:

- 1. Click the "App Store" icon on your Apple device.
- 2. Type your school name in the search, using suburb name will help.
- 3. You will see your school appear, click "Get" then "install".
- 4. The app is FREE to download.
- When installed click "Open"
- Select "OK" to receive push notifications, when asked.
- 7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
- 8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.





For Android users:

You must first have signed up with a Google Account before installing the app.

- 1. Click the "Play Store" button on your Android Device
- 2. Click the magnifying glass icon at the top and type in your school name, using suburb name will help.
- 3. Click the school name when it appears in the search.
- Click the "Install" button.
- 5. Click "Accept" for various permissions (please note, we do not modify any of your personal data on your device).
- Click "Open" when installed.
- 7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
- 8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.

Please Note: Some brands of Android phones need the setting in "Notification Manager" changed to "Allow" instead of "Notify" in order for the push notifications to work. The phone must also be running at least version 4 system software to run the app.



For Windows 81 Phone and Windows 81 or 10 device users:

- 1. Go to the Windows Store on your 8.1 Windows Phone or Windows 8.1/10 Device
- 2. Search for "Skoolbag" in the keyword app search
- 3. Install the Skoolbag app
- 4. Find your school either by using the keyword search or location service.
- 5. Click the "Pin" icon to pin the school tile to your Windows Phone home screen.
- 6. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup"
- 7. Toggle the Push Categories that are applicable to you by tapping the on/off switch.

Please Note: The Skoolbag Windows App is for 81 version Windows Phones, or Windows 81 and 10 devices.
