Getting a late note when coming to school after 9am

All schools have a responsibility to keep accurate rolls of when students are at school and if they arrive or leave school outside of the hours between 9am and 3pm.

If your child arrives after 9am, they must go to the office to get a late note. If they don't do this then we don't have an official record of them arriving at school. And...if we don't have an official record of them arriving at school, then you will receive a notification that your child is not at school and asking you to provide an explanation of their absence.

Receiving a notification that your child is not at school when you expect that they are at school is incredibly stressful.

Students do not get 'into trouble' for coming late. We want our students at school. However, if students come late to school and do not come to the office, there is a chance that you will receive a notification letting you know that your child is not at school.

If your child comes to school late, please remind them to come to the office.

We have spoken to the students about this as well.




